Guiding Principles of the Wexford Conservancy Architectural Review Board

Vision:

Apply Architectural Standards Fairly And Impartially Based On The Conservancy Documents.

Mission:

The Architectural Review Board shall regulate the external design, appearance, and locations of the Properties and improvements thereon in such a manner so as to **preserve and enhance values** and to **maintain a harmonious relationship** among structures and the natural vegetation and topography. (Bylaws; Article IX Architectural Review Board; Section 5. Duties.; Page 17-18)

Objectives:

- 1. Communicate to increase resident awareness and understanding of the Covenants.
- 2. Communicate to describe the organizations and procedures involved with the architectural standards established by the Covenants.
- 3. Communicate to illustrate design principles that will aid residents in developing exterior improvements which are in harmony with the immediate neighborhood and the community as a whole.
- 4. Communicate to assist residents in preparing an acceptable application to the Architectural Review Board.
- 5. Communicate To relate exterior improvements to the plans for Wexford Conservancy.
- 6. Communicate to provide uniform guidelines to be used by the ARB in reviewing applications with respect to the Founding Documents of the Wexford Conservancy and actions of the Conservancy Board of Trustees. <u>Duties:</u>

- (a) Review and approve, modify or disapprove, within forty-five days, all written applications of Owners and of the Conservancy for improvements or additions (as described in article VII of the declaration) to Lots, Living Units or Common Area;
- (b) Periodically inspect the Properties for compliance with architectural standards and approved plans for alteration;
- (c) Adopt architectural guidelines and programs subject to the confirmation of the Board of Trustees;
- (d) Adopt procedures for the exercise of its duties and enter them in the Book of Resolutions;
- (e) Maintain complete and accurate records of all actions taken; and
- (f) (The Board members may) Utilize staff and other assistance in inspecting the properties and maintaining its records (where appropriate).
